

32. No space may be closed, vacated and/or torn down until at least 10PM on the last day of the Fair.
33. All displays and display material must be removed from the Fairgrounds by three (3) calendar days following the close of the Fair or they will become property of the Allen County Agricultural Society.
34. Only items listed on your contract may be sold from or displayed in your space.
35. Food and or beverages may not be served in glass containers.
36. Each person contracting concession or exhibit space must purchase either a membership card or a season pass for each contract written. One free season pass will be given for each space contracted. Extra season passes may be purchased, if desired.
37. No campers or sleeping quarters are permitted in any of the Fairgrounds except in the designated camping areas. All campers and sleeping quarters must pay the camping fee.
38. At the expiration of each contract, the space shall be surrendered to the Society in as good repair as when possession was taken.
39. The Society shall have a lien upon all property being kept, used or situated upon the Fairgrounds, for rent or privilege, money to be paid under their contract and for any damages sustained; the Society shall have the right to restrain the same without process of law, and appropriate the property to satisfy all claims against the concessions.
40. The violation of the terms, conditions or provisions of a contract shall, at the election of the Society's Directors, cause the whole amount of the contract to become due and work a revocation and forfeiture of all rights and privileges granted to the concession. In the event such breach and such election, any and all sums paid or contracted to be paid under a contract to the Society, shall be and become the property of the Society as liquidated damages of said breach.
41. Lighters must be sold empty. The lighter may be filled at the request of an adult.
42. No reptiles, silly string or laser lights to be sold or given away as prizes. No knives, of any kind. No Profanity or objectionable words written on merchandise.

5. Divisions will race for an equal share of the total purse.

CONDITIONS
1. Western Ohio Colt stake conditions as published. U.S.T.A. rules to govern all races with exceptions.
2. Money divided 45 - 25 - 15 - 10 - 5 percent. Four Starters 50 - 25 - 15 - 10 percent. Three Starters 50 - 30 - 20 percent. In the event there are less than three (3) starters the race is declared off. The Horsemen's nomination, sustaining and declaration fees will be distributed equally to the horses declared in the Superstakes race.
3. Early declarations for all racing events to be made not later than 11 AM, three (3) days preceding the race.
4. Entries made over the telephone must be made to the Race Secretary 419.228.6303, NOT THE FAIR OFFICE!
5. Veterinarian will be on the grounds for Lassix injections.
6. Right reserved to change program or reject any entries.
7. SPECIAL GATE for all Horsemen to enter is on Bowman Road by the horse barn. Gate Admission is \$6. WOCRA passes will be honored on racing days.
8. The Society assumes no liability in case of accident.

Pace Track Record 1:55.2 Set by Odysus A 2003  
Trot Track Record 1:59.4 Set by One Final Time 2004

\$5,000 (divided \$4,000 to owner and \$1,000 to driver) will be paid to the horse setting a new track record at either gait for the entire 2011 race program provided the posted track record is lowered by 1 full second or more. In case of a tie, Bounty will be divided among record holders.
